Mayor addressed Board with updates

- -Michael Newell wants to install an outdoor wood-burning furnace
 - -Board sees no problem as long as he meets requirements
 - -Mayor to forward him State regulations and guidelines
- -the sidewalk law will be put on Village web-site
- -newsletter will go out with water bills

Commissioner Robinson gave update on water and sewer

- -reverse 911 is working when needed
- -Dig Safely is using a new system that better locates our waterlines
- -water tank was low at one point; asked that Board pay attention to alarm at Stiles' House
- -getting solar batteries coming in from Kingston Solar
- -hasn't talked to Randy Cuthbert on meter progress but wants to start reading meters this spring
 - -will need to do samplings for a calendar year
- -grant money for sewer projects is available through EFC
 - -they do require easements from home to line if existing septic tanks are used
- -CDGB has money for service entances(hook-ups)
- -discharge of waste would need to be disinfected, at least in summer, to protect Moseskill
- -Trustee Mackenzie asked about other types of sewer treatment systems
- -Jason Danno from Rural Water needs all Village information by August of 2014
- -archeological study needs to be done before applying for grants
 - -Village needs to get 3 bids
