Mayor stated that resident Dennis Sherman was given permit to install wood stove in his home.

Water Commissioner Robinson updated Board on water situation.

- needed approval to get well up and running and needed parts to get it pumping
- state of emergency management made it possible to get water from Ft. Edward
 - tanker came from SEMO
 - Ft. Edward supplied water
 - county supplied tractor and driver
- DOH says we need a filtration when we augment wells
- boil water will be in affect for a while
- DOH wants schedule for facility plan
- more daily samples taken
- County property tapped out for new water supply
 - County owns lane at infirmary, may be able to dig well at fire pond and connect to well #3
- DOH wants boil water and updates on website
 - wants report that outlines alternatives and what Village plans to implement
- Randy Cuthbert is no loner a certified water engineer
 - Village needs to hire Mark Dennison

On a motion made by Trustee McDowell, seconded by Trustee Mackenzie, and carried to Board made a resolution naming Mark Dennison operator on record for a salary of \$250.00 a month.
