

Minutes from December 7, 2015 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Those in attendance: Mayor Wesley Clark; Trustees Cher McCotter, Joanne McDowell, Joseph Lohret; Water Commissioner Garry Robinson, Clerk Joyann Stimpson; Greenwich Journal Reporter Cait Johnston.

Meeting called to order at 5:30 P.M.

Mayor set schedule for spring meetings, Jan. 4, Feb. 1, Mar. 14, April 4 all of 2016; starting May 2 meetings to be held back at the Ransom Stiles' House; June 6.

Elections to be held in March; Mayor Clark is up for re-election as is two Trustees Jonathan Mackenzie and Joanne McDowell.

Water Commissioner Robinson updated Board on water situation and meetings with Dept. of Health and sources for grant funding.

- Gretchen Flinkal from USDA has potential funding
 - plan development money may be available
 - need to send information to get on list
- village qualifies for no interest loan from EFC if repairs are done within 2 years
- Steve Winkley sent files showing current wells and their production
- village could use Summit Lake
 - would have to agree to use cartridge filter, they are inexpensive to do and can be cleaned
 - need to get filtration plan now in case wells can't keep up with demand
 - will need to get heated shed
- Dept. of Health has to approve everything
- must keep looking for a new well

On a motion made by Trustee McDowell, seconded by Trustee McCotter, and carried, the Board stated that Commissioner Robinson was to proceed with plans for filtration system from a Summit Lake extraction point within goal to provide an emergency back-up source.

On a motion made by Trustee McCotter; seconded by Trustee McDowell; and carried; the minutes were accepted as written.

On a motion made by Trustee Lohret; seconded by Mayor Clark; and carried; the Clerk is allowed to pay warrants for month of December.
