Argyle Village Board Meeting for January 2, 2017

Those in attendance: Mayor Wesley Clark; Trustees Jonathan Mackenzie, Cher McCotter, Joanne McDowell, Joseph Lohret; Water Commissioner Garry Robinson; Clerk Joyann Stimpson; and Journal Press Reporter Cait Johnston.

Meeting called to order 5:28

Elections are to be held on March 21, 2017 and Joanne McDowell and Joseph Lohret have agreed to run for re-election. Clerk will have petitions for them as well as others for any people interested in running.

Mayor informed Board that he has been in contact with the owner of the Old IGA property and he is looking for someone to help him repair the damaged sign on the building. Mayor Clark stated that the Village really has no options for that property.

Water Commissioner Robinson updated Board on several issues.

-there are 2 service shut-offs at the Lafoy and Myott properties; the t-lines were kept. A valve stem shut-off was put at Lafoy property. The sidewalk will need to be repaired.

-need to go to second level of water conservation at this time. Commissioner will be notice on Front Porch Forum and ask residents to inform Village if any water leaks appear.

-County has a proposal to turn property that the water tank and wells are on over to the Town. The Village will need to have its Attorney look over the paper work.

-DOH will not allow using Summit Lake as a water supply and will provide education regarding algae

-Village needs to advertise on Front Porch Forum to find someone to plow well site 3-5

-Leise can drill new well at Stiles' property.

-there will be no impact on ball fields

-we need 2in. drill test

-we need to look for bids

-must have DOH approval

-Village needs to look for other plumber to finish installing meters

The informed Board that flood maps are available but there is no flood plain data available for Argyle.

Jon Mackenzie has a proposal for a distillery at his property

-not changing the footprint of the property

-in a separate building on property

-meets state regulations

-truck load of grain will be delivered monthly

-product will be sold at Argyle Brewery in Greenwich
