Meeting called to order at 5:30 P.M.

Mayor Clark updated board on several issues

- -roll over appointments of Ian Hamilton and Marcus Butterfield
- -to put into budget raising election inspectors pay according minimum wage

On a motion made by Trustee Mackenzie; seconded by Trustee McCotter; and carried; the Election inspectors will be paid according to minimum wage now and in the future.

- -need budget item for concrete as Steve Reid, Jan Cole, Arlin Wells, and the Methodist Church all want new sidewalks
- -phase 2 of archaeology study is in the budget
- -the town is planning a meeting with DEC to discuss blue algae affecting Summit Lake on May 10, 2017 at the firehouse
- -May board meeting is set for May 8, 2017 at the Stiles' House as Mayor will be out of town on May 1.

Commissioner Robinson gave his report to the board.

- -Leise is to check on problem with well # 2
- DOH wants pump test done on new well. It is a 72 hour test, has to have 8 hours of stabilization, and has to be done on well # 6 as well.
- -the new well would be an unlisted project and the Village can be lead agent for SEQR
- -there can be no septic or parking area within 200 feet of well #7
- -Commissioner to contact Steve Winkler about well # 7
- -barn at Stiles' House cannot be used as is so the Village will need to purchase a 12x12 shed
- -Commissioner to meet with DOH for approval
- -Village needs testing done this summer for lead and copper and samples must be taken from homes
- -there may be a leak at County Farm Rd.

- -new water pipe detector and flags for directing traffic need to be purchased
- -Randy Cuthbert is good to go to install meters in 7 homes per month until October 2017

On a motion made by Trustee McCotter; seconded by Trustee McDowell; and carried; the Board allowed Clerk to pay warrants for month of April.

On a motion made by Trustee McCotter; seconded by Trustee McDowell; and carried; the board approved minutes of March Board meeting with spelling corrections.
