-not sure we are eligible for EFC draft

-priority score is 31

-funding line is 48

-village project is \$4 million

-need new engineering plan

-stage 2 archaeological study needs to be done this spring

The Village has to make a resolution regarding violence in the workplace and on a motion made by Trustee McCotter; seconded by Trustee McDowell; and carried, the Village adopted the Towns resolution.

Town Supervisor Robert Henke came in to tell the Board about the sidewalk plans

-at the time of the study Mr. Henke did not realize that the firehouse is the shelter in place

for the school and was not included in the study
