

May 6, 2019 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Budget hearing called to order at 5:33 P.M.

Trustee Clark explained all the lines for the 2019-2020 budget and they were open to discussion. On a motion made by Trustee Clark; seconded by Trustee McCotter; and carried, the 2019-2020 budget was passed.

- the DOH accepted the timeline for when the new well will be up and running
- a new meter was installed at one of the wells

- intake building has not been repaired and Commissioner Robinson will contact Washington County

Lamont Engineers informed the Board on their waste treatment systems; different types of systems; what the Village needed to do to upgrade plan for its system; and where to find funding for the project.
