## May 4, 2020 Argyle Village Board Meeting

## Zoom Meeting

Those in attendance: Mayor Jonathan MacKenzie, Trustees Wesley Clark, Charles Edwards, Cher McCotter, Anthony Montello, Water Commissioner Garry Robinson, Clerk Joyann Stimpson.

Budget Hearing called to order 5:34 P.M.

Trustee Clark presented the budget, explaining the current line items. Mayor MacKenzie thanked Mr. Clark for continuing to utilize his expertise to help with the village budget. During the discussion it was noted that the water fund did not include the 2020 rate increase for water rents.

On a motion made by Trustee Clark, seconded by Trustee McCotter, and carried, the 2020-2021 budget was passed with an amendment to update using the increase of the water rents.

Trustee McCotter mentioned to the Board that the Methodist Church would like to have the water turned on at their manse so that they could work on it.

Commissioner Robinson updated the Board on water

-need to keep reading the meters for DOH and collecting data

-trees had to be cleared around the area of well#2 so that Leise could get his equipment

in to service the well

-DOT says we have to have open cutting for hooking up the new well

-we need an easement from the Presbyterian Church to connect at 3 different spots

-we will need longer pipe and the directional drilling will be expensive

On a motion made by Trustee Clark, seconded by Trustee McCotter, and carried, the Clerk

Was allowed to pay warrants for the month of May.

On a motion made by Trustee Clark, seconded by Trustee Montello, and carried, the minutes for the April 6, 2020 board meeting were accepted as written with an amendment regarding the effect of COVID-19 on the essential businesses in Argyle.
