- -village qualifies for no interst loan from EFC if repairs are done within 2 years
- -Steve Winkley sent files showing current wells and their production
- -village could use Summit Lake
 - -would have to agree to use cartridge filter, they are inexpensive to do and can be cleaned
 - -neeed to get filtration plan now in case wells can't keep up with demand
 - -will need to get heated shed
- -Dept. of Health has to approve everthing
- -must keep looking for a new well
