Clerk informed Board that the Village needed to be compliant with the State with our record keeping

- -Board had to adopt the State MU-1
- -had to appoint clerk as Records Management Officer
- -have to find safe, adequate, and controlled environment for the records
- -the Village is eligible for grant money to cover the cost
- -Stiles' House is an option
- -Clerk to reach out to other municipalities to find out what they are doing for storage

The Clerk informed Board they had until December 31, 2019 to meet requirements for adopting the violence in the workplace policy and could take it with any organization who was doing it.

- -Village is searching for available funding sources
