

Minutes of September 12,2011 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Those in attendance: Mayor Wesley Clark, Trustees: Peter Bailey, Joseph Lohret, Joanne McDowell, Water Commissioner Garry Robinson, Clerk Joyann Stimpson.

Meeting opened at 5:31 P.M.

Mayor addressed Board with an update on the sidewalk grant.

- will not be done this year
- Commissioner Robinson has maps and will assist Mayor
- sidewalks will go through driveways

Trustee Bailey gave update from Stiles' Committee.

- brick campaign has begun
- tore off back porch
- car show will be October 8, 2011; vendors will be there as well
(port-a-john will be delivered)
- haunted house will be October 27th & 28th
 - Stiles' Committee received a letter from John Perry, a descendent of Ransom Stiles

Commissioner Robinson gave water report.

- Commissioner to handle EJP billing issues
- Mayor delivered shut-off notices to residents about water main break
- DOT to do paving of Sheridan Street at break site
- problems with delivering end of boil water notices
 - put on Presbyterian Church bulletin board
(Trustee McCotter said that could be put on Methodists board)
- will see about putting on school's bulletin board
- need to order pumps for wells if they fail

Board decided that the October meeting will be at Stiles' House with future meetings to be at the J.A. Barkley Fire House through the winter months starting with November 7th meeting

Mayor discussed Nuisance Law that the Village of Greenwich implemented.

- most of Board felt the law was excessive
- Argyle has no one to enforce law
- Mayor to speak to Attorney Radner for advice in how to proceed
- was mentioned that Glenn Bristol, (he holds a position with the fire company) was a person who could be called upon to investigate people burning in the Village
- Village needs to contact Washington County to see about Emergency Plans

Mayor told the Board about the interest at the bank dropping to .04%.

Trustee Lohret made motion to accept minutes as written; Trustee McDowell seconded; all voted in favor of; motion carried.

Trustee McDowell made motion to allow Clerk to pay warrants for month of September; Trustee Bailey seconded; all voted in favor of; motion carried.

Trustee McDowell mentioned that the ACET Committee is looking into using the Stiles' House as a satellite center for ACC's continuing education program.

Trustee Bailey made motion for the Board to cover the events at the Stiles' House under its insurance; Trustee Lohret seconded; all voted in favor of; motion carried.

Trustee Bailey made motion to close meeting; Mayor seconded; all voted in favor of; motion carried.
