

## February 7, 2012 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Those in attendance: Mayor Wes Clark; Trustees Joseph Lohret, Cher McCotter, Joanne McDowell; Clerk Joyann Stimpson; Water Commissioner Garry Robinson; and Ed Curtin from Curtain Archaeology.

Mayor called meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.

Mr. Curtin addressed Board with results of archaeology study.

- nothing found at sewage treatment site
- no Native American sites discovered
- DEC and USDA-Army Corps of Engineers would do a more in depth study
- State Historic Preservation will need letter of findings

Mr. Curtin feels that Phase II study is necessary

- will cost about \$9,600.00
- takes about two weeks
- 2 things to address
  - wants to go through Stiles' House
  - Archaeological site plan

Mayor addressed Board on sidewalk grant

- Mayor has not heard from Mike Stella, State Engineer Approving Plans
- Highway Superintendent Humiston has concerns over flagging at work site-may be able to get help from State
- Mike Newell and Larry Ashcroft might be called to help with removal

Trustee McCotter made motion to allow Clerk to pay warrants; Trustee McDowell seconded; all voted in favor of motion carried.

Trustee McDowell made motion to accept minutes as written; Trustee McCotter seconded; all voted in favor of; motion carried.
