

April 5, 2014 Argyle village Board Meeting

Those in attendance: Mayor Wesley Clark; Trustees Jonathan Mackenzie, Cher McCotter, Joanne McDowell, Joseph Lohret; Water Commissioner Garry Robinson; and Clerk Joyann Stimpson.

Meeting called to order at 5:25 P.M.

Mayor updated Board on several issues

- Dollar General no longer looking at McClenning property because of the 55mph speed limit
- Lufkin family is looking to hook-up to Village water supply and as the water line shows up on their property map it is possible
  - as of April 4, 2014 they have not gotten in touch with Commissioner as they were advised
- next meeting will be held at Stiles's House and will be there until the November meeting
- if the Trustees' have anything they wish to have entered into the budget they are to get it to him before May meeting

Commissioner Robinson informed Board that the water tank is back up to the proper level but the leak has yet to be found.

The Board is in agreement that Phase 2 of the sewer project should be started.

- Trustee Mackenzie asked if a Ban Note could be done
- discussion on raising a sewer tax
  - when to start and how much to charge
  - must have public hearing
- Trustee Lohret stated a need for a separate checking account for sewer project

On a motion made by Trustee McCotter, seconded by Trustee Mackenzie, and carried the minutes from the March 3, 2014 Board meeting were accepted as written.

On a motion made by Trustee McCotter, seconded by Trustee McDowell, and carried, the Clerk was allowed to pay warrants for month of April.

On a motion made by Trustee Lohret, seconded by Trustee Mackenzie, and carried, the meeting adjourned at 6:15 P.M.
