

Draft of February 1, 2016 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Those in attendance: Mayor Wesley Clark; Trustees Jonathan Mackenzie, Cher McCotter, Joanne McDowell, Joseph Lohret; Water Commissioner Garry Robinson; Clerk Joyann Stimpson; and Journal Press report Cait Johnston.

Meeting called to order at 5:31 P.M.

On a motion made by Trustee McCotter, seconded by Trustee Mackenzie, and carried the board approved an agreement with Washington County to allow the village Planning Board to act first and inform the County Planning Board later.

Elections are set for March 15, 2016 to take place upstairs at the Town office building from noon until 9 P.M.

Water Commissioner Robinson updated Board

- Steve Winkler talked to Leise about land for new well
 - need disinfection at Lufkin farm
 - cannot have any salt contamination
- need to talk to Leo at Greenwich about the filters the DOH wants
- plans to get filtration system to use in emergency from Summit Lake
 - the Village will self fund the engineering work for the new water source to meet the February 19th deadline of the DOH
- ISO to test water system for insurance, no change in the fire flow
- may need new solar panels at the wells

The Board agreed to forgo the past due water bills at the Cook property and asked for the snow removal charges.

On a motion made by Trustee McDowell, seconded by Trustee Lohret, and carried the minutes were accepted as written.

On a motion made by Trustee Mackenzie, seconded by Trustee McDowell, and carried the clerk was allowed to pay warrants for month of February.

On a motion made by Trustee Lohret, seconded by Trustee Mackenzie, and carried the meeting adjourned at 6:36 P.M.
