

Draft of May 8, 2017 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Those in attendance: Mayor Wesley Clark; Trustees Jonathan Mackenzie, Cher McCotter, Joanne McDowell, Water Commissioner Garry Robinson, Clerk Joyann Stimpson, and Journal Reporter Cait Johnston.

Mayor opened public hearing at 5:30 P.M.

Mayor stated that there is a tax cap increase of 1.3% which would be a tax base of \$2.33 per \$1,000.00 that would generate a budget of \$28,716.00 for the 2017-2018 calendar year. On a motion made by Trustee McCotter; seconded by Trustee McDowell; and carried; the 2017-2018 budget was passed.

Mayor updated board on several issues.

- Governor created a shared services board at county level
- the glass door at old IGA is broken and Mayor will notify Mr. Marcus.
- lock to Stiles is broken and needs to be replaced
- Stiles' Committee wants to preserve barn for water treatment tanks
- Mayor showed Town clerk where new well is going and will put flag at the site

Water Commissioner Robinson updated Board.

- plans for new well need to be finished for Dept. of Health by end of summer
- Mike Shaw may be in charge of Dept. of Health issues
- Steve Winkley to come in May to locate new well
- lead and copper testing to be done on 5 homes this summer
- Jonathan Mackenzie to add water hook-up to existing line for water service to business building
- State money is available for sewer and water projects

On a motion made by Trustee McCotter; seconded by Trustee Mackenzie; and carried; the Clerk was allowed to pay warrants for month of May.

On a motion made by Trustee McCotter; seconded by Trustee McDowell; and carried; the minutes for the April 2017 Board Meeting were accepted as written.
