

January 13, 2022 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Those in attendance: Mayor Wesley Clark, Trustees Charles Edwards, Joy MacKenzie, Anthony Montello, Water Commissioner Garry Robinson, Clerk Joyann Stimpson, Sarah Huggins. Those attending through Zoom, Carol Kuhr, Joanne McDowell.

Mayor stated that elections would be held on March 15, 2022 with Charles Edwards and Cher McCotter up for Trustee re-election as well as Wesley Clark for Mayor. Petitions need to be turned into Clerks office by February 8, 2022. Elections will be held in the Presbyterian Church from 12 noon until 9 P.M.

Water Commissioner Robinson gave his water report

- we have until April 30, 2022 to have well 7 up and running
- DOH wants stamped and approved plans for the well by February 28, 2022.
- all electrical work is done and heat is in well house 7
- we are having delays due to suppliers not being able to get parts
- 10 homes need to get tested for iron
- Morris Coolidge will be new water operator and he wishes to be paid yearly.

Mayor Clark asked for newsletter topics such as sidewalks and increase in water rates.

Board made a list of projects to be turned into EFC by June 1, 2022

- putting in shut-off valves
- replace mains throughout Village

On a motion made by Trustee MacKenzie, seconded by Trustee Edwards, and carried, the Clerk was allowed to pay warrants for month of January 2022.
