

October 3, 2022 Argyle Village Board Meeting

On a motion made by Trustee MacKenzie, seconded by Trustee Hamilton, and carried the meeting was called to order at 5:34 P.M.

On a motion made by Trustee Hamilton, seconded by Trustee MacKenzie, and carried, the minutes from the September 6, 2022 Village Board meeting were accepted as written.

Candace Balmer is the Resource Specialist representing RCAP Solutions and presented the Board with the project steps to move forward on a sewer project. On a motion made by Trustee MacKenzie, seconded by Trustee Hamilton, and carried, the Board signed an agreement with RCAP Solutions.

Sarah Huggins representing the AIA, presented the Board with pictures of the sidewalks throughout the Village and pointed out which were in the most need of repair.

The Board discussed what needed to be done to improve the language of the water bills. On a motion made by Trustee Steinberger, seconded by Trustee MacKenzie, and carried, the Board agreed to give the residents 90 days notice to bring past due water rents current before the water was shut off.

On a motion made by Trustee Hamilton, seconded by Trustee MacKenzie, and carried, the Board agreed to sign the Intermunicipal Agreement between the Village and Washington County and update our local laws.

On a motion made by Trustee Montello, seconded by Trustee Hamilton, and carried, the Clerk was allowed to pay warrants for the month of October except for Water Commissioner Robinson's until the warrant is explained and justified.

On a motion made by Trustee Steinberger, seconded by Trustee MacKenzie, and carried, the meeting adjourned at 7:42 P.M.
