

November 7, 2022 Argyle Village Board Meeting

On a motion made by Trustee Hamilton, seconded by Trustee MacKenzie, and carried, the meeting was called to order at 5:34 P.M.

On a motion made by Trustee MacKenzie, seconded by Trustee Hamilton, and carried, the minutes from the October 3, 2022 were accepted as written.

Mr. Kitchener and Mr. Ernenwein were there on behalf of the Youth Commission to ask for approval to build a parking lot and picnic pavilion on Village property. Mayor Smith needs to check to make sure it has approval as far as the flood plan goes and Clerk Stimpson needs to contact DOH about the specifications regarding the new well. On a motion made by Trustee Hamilton, seconded by Trustee MacKenzie, and carried, the Board gave approval for the project as long as there was no cost to the Village.

The Board agreed to table RCAP Solution survey until February, 2023.

Water Commissioner Robinson reported to the Board that there was a leak at well #1 when it was pumping and rural water was coming to help find it.

Sarah Huggins reported to the Board on AIA findings regarding sidewalks and the meeting they had with Benjamin Marcus , owner of the former IGA building.

On a motion made by Trustee Steinberger, seconded by Trustee MacKenzie, and carried, the Clerk was allowed to pay warrants for month of November, 2022.

On a motion made by Trustee Hamilton, seconded by Trustee MacKenzie and carried, the meeting adjourned at 6:58 P.M.

The Board stated that December meeting would be at 5:30 P.M. on December 5, 2022 and January 9, 2023, both at the firehouse.
