

June 3, 2024 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Meeting called to order at 5:31.

On a motion made by Trustee Hamilton, seconded by Trustee St. John, and unanimously carried, the minutes from the May 6, 2024 Board Meeting were accepted as written.

Commissioner Gorman gave the Board his water report.

- the water tank will be inspected by USGA Water at no charge
- the area surrounding well house 1 will be cleaned up and the debris removed but the fence stays
- lead testing has to be done
- there is a problem as to the shut-off at 533 West Street
- attorney needs to be called regarding shut-off costs
- review of the rules regarding water shut-off, village attorney needs to be contacted
- laws need to be passed regarding residents putting in private wells

Brenden Becker spoke of budget for the sewer project.

- Bond resolution needs to be passed
- to replace everything that needs to be replaced the cost is about 11 million dollars
- need to redo Brennan Road well house
- rate study needs to be done
- state claims affordable rate \$800.00 for sewer
- increase rate for commercial customers
- a new concrete tank would cost about 2 million dollars
- keep chlorination in the distribution lines
- prioritize easements for going through the backyards of residents properties

Jack Mans reported to the Board on the sidewalks

- there will be a public notice sent out in July
- crossing templates have been
- handicap parking has to be made available
