

## July 1, 2024 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Meeting called to order at 5:30 P.M.

On a motion made by Trustee St. John, seconded by Trustee MacKenzie, and unanimously carried, the minutes from the June 3, 2024 were accepted as written.

Mayor Smith asked the Board to accept the amendment regarding the estimated cost of the 20 million dollars for the waste treatment project. On a motion made by the Mayor, the Board voted for the WQYW grant application as follows:

Water Commissioner Gorman gave his water report

- lead and copper tests were taken with 100% feed- back from the homes tested
- the water tank interior passed inspection
- outside needs to be painted and can be included in the grant
- Town Highway Superintendent St, Jocques stated his department would aid in cleaning up at water tank
- lean-to needs to be removed
- water rates need to be established
- lead services have to be addressed, Commissioner Gorham will send out letters and the residents can leave their information at the library
- there is a sever rodent problem at wells2-6

Trustee St. John has started with the log-in process concerning pro-housing in the village.

AIA reported to the Board the following information

- the work regarding cross walks has started
- the sale of the old school has fallen out
- Ben Marcus has to be notified about his failure to maintain his property

Code Enforcement Officer John Graham has to be informed of the two campers that are parked on two residents properties with people living in them.

Next Board meeting is scheduled for August 5, 2024.

On a motion made by Trustee MacKenzie, seconded by Trustee Montello, and unanimously carried, the clerk was allowed to pay warrants for the month of August 2024.
