

Village of Argyle September 2,2024 Board Meeting

Meeting called to order 5:34.

On a motion made by Trustee St. John, seconded by Trustee Hamilton, and unanimously carried, the minutes from the August 12,2024 Board meeting were accepted as written.

Jack Mance from the Adirondack Transportation gave an overview of the sidewalk project for the Village of Argyle.

- looked at existing conditions
- looked at overall road way
- AIA very through getting survey out
- priorities were taken into account
- draft will be posted on their website
- project can be broken down to do in sections
- total cost for complete project \$3.7 million
- offered to help with grant information
- 30 day close-out report

EFC reported that the drinking water received high points, but the waste water did not because the Moseskill is not a threat.

Water Commissioner Gorham gave his report

- wells were all working but wells 3 and 5 were running low
- mid September is when the meters will be read

Chris Castrio informed the Board that work was going to be done on the Stiles House, some brick work needed to be done and gutters needed work. This is the last work that Mr. Castrio will be involved with. The handicapped ramp will not be done.

Scott Lufkin suggested to the Board that they may want to consider selling the Stiles House with deed restrictions, and buying the old IGA and making that into the village 's office.

Thistle Day is September 28, 2024 at the Lufkin Tractor Pull property.

Clerk was advised to check out Walmart for the purchase of a shedder for the Village office.

On a motion made by Trustee Montello, seconded by Trustee Hamilton, and unanimously carried, the Clerk was allowed to pay the warrants for the month of September, 2024.
