

November 4, 2024 Argyle Village Board Meeting

Those in attendance: Mayor Darren Smith, Trustees Anthony Montello, Ian Hamilton, Joy MacKenzie, Clerk Joyann Stimpson, Water Commissioner Kevin Gorman, Michele Rice, Tracy Lucerelli, Carol Kuhr, Scott Lufkin, Sarah Huggins.

Meeting called to order at 5:30 P.M.

Mayor Smith stated that the village will be moving forward with the WIA Grant to improve the water supply. Candance Balmer with RCAP will be aiding the village with the income survey from the village residents.

Commissioner Gorman gave his water report.

- wells 3&5, which are the least productive of all the wells, were at a low point, partly because it was so dry this fall.

- most people have returned the information regarding the lead pipe connection at the inside

Trustee Hamilton went through the local laws of the Village and found that the Village does have laws in place that prohibit people living in campers. Mayor Smith will be calling the Sheriff's department so that the campers can be removed. Do we need to call Laeh about this.?

Trustee St.John was not able to attend meeting so the village will wait until the December meeting to continue on talks regarding the Old IGA building on Main Street.

The village needs to get an appraiser to go into the Stiles' house to confirm its value as is.

AIA is looking at a resource plan for water and sewer, and looking at getting a cross walk from the school to the Firehouse. The crosswalks through the village are finished as they are but we can ask DOT to fill in the crosshatch pattern if there is a need.
